

# MPCC TEAM MOM RESPONSIBILITIES

1. You will be assigned a Cheerleading squad.
2. You will be assigned a Football team to cheer for on a weekly basis
  - A football team and game schedule will be emailed to you once we receive these from the Mt. Prospect Football Association
  - Once a football team is assigned, we will provide you with the football coach's email and hopefully phone number. Please contact him to let him know that your squad will be cheering for his team. Coordinate homecoming festivities\* with football coach. If you have any questions regarding homecoming, please contact the MPCC board.

## \*HOMECOMING FESTIVITIES

- Coordinate with the football coach on the following:
- Pre-game: Includes meeting for car decorating, hair painting, - (Optional donuts, coffee and drinks for the kids) and parade to football field.
- Post-game: The football coach will let you know the type of post-game activity if any.
- Any questions and/or need help, please contact your MPCC board

3. You will be assigned a Jr. coach for your cheerleading squad who will teach all the cheers and moves. She will also be responsible, with your supervision, for teaching the squad a half time routine and a Cheer Off routine.
4. Coordinate day and time of weekly practices.
5. Attend and supervise weekly practices.

6. Attend weekly football game with squad during season.
- Hopefully your cheer coach will be able to attend the games. If she is able to attend, she will call out the cheers and give direction when it comes to cheering and to the half time routine. As Team Mom you are there as a leader & in charge in case anything comes up.  
If the cheer coach is not able to attend the weekly game, as Team Mom you will supervise your squad at the weekly game. This includes calling out cheers and giving direction when it comes to cheering and to the half time routine.
  - If for some reason you are unable to attend a weekly game, please coordinate with another parent of the squad to be there at the game in your place. Notify squad of parent in charge at that game.

7. Always have the first aid kit with you at games and practices. Please be sure that your first aid kit is always completely stocked. You can do this yourself or call us and we will get you extra supplies.

8. Be the liaison between the parents and the Jr. Coach. We ask that the parents communicate with you and not your Jr. Coach. She should not be approached with any questions or concerns.

9. Try to keep up on MPCC news and events. The parents are always sent e-mails of all upcoming events, but we ask that you communicate this as well. All cheerleaders will be given a folder to bring to all practices and games. You can choose to use their folder for any communication or you may communicate via e-mail. Whatever you find works best for your squad.

10. Be present for pictures. We like to have our team moms and coaches in our team picture. It is not a must. You can opt out of the picture, but we ask that you try to be there to organize your squad.

11. Present medals and trophies. At the cheer off all participating cheerleaders will receive a medal. At the banquet all cheerleaders receive a trophy. We like for these to be presented by the team moms.

12. Assist in getting head counts from your squad on the various MPCC sponsored events.

13. Hand out uniforms, special order spirit wear and anything else from the MPCC board to your squad on an as needed basis.
